Together with the local accommodaton office “Ungdomsbo” we have made a special offer to Erasmus/Exchange students about furnished accommodation.

Usually the student accommodation in Denmark is without furniture, kitchen equipment etc and for this reason we are cooperating with “Ungdomsbo” about furnished rooms for our students coming from abroad and for a limited period of time.

As an ERASMUS/exchange student you have to sign up and agree that you will pay for an already settled period of exchange – see below:

Periods for accommodation:

Spring semester: **15th January – 15th July**(school semester: 15th January – ultimo June)

Fall semester: **15th August – 15th January** (school semester: 29th August – ultimo December (mid January))

Furniture:

The furniture available for each student is: Bed, sofa, table, chair, study table, lamps and basic kitchen equipment. At departure the equipment will be inspected.

Types of Accommodation:

Hedelundvej:



4 persons house with own room, shared kitchen and shared bathrooms. IT connection for own computer available (applicable).

Rent: DKK 2471.- per month, Maintenance fee: DKK 500.- (one time payment) Deposit: DKK 3900.- (will be returned at departure)

Georg:



Single apartments with shared kitchen and own bathroom. IT connection for own computer available (applicable). Rent: DKK 2204.- Deposit: DKK 4400.- Maintenance fee: DKK 500.- (one time payment)

Vognsbøl:



Two persons apartment with shared kitchen and shared bathroom. Recommended for couple. IT connection for own computer available (applicable). 2 persons apartment - rent: DKK 4426.- Maintenance fee: DKK 500.- (one time payment) Deposit: DKK 8000.- (will be returned at departure)

!!!! Please be aware that the rent can increase every year and the above rent could change before you arrive. You will be notified about this in due time.

Other option:

You can also choose to apply for accommodation directly with the accommodation office “Ungdomsbo” but you have to be aware that you will be put on a waiting list together with other regular students and you have to follow the rules related to this type of application procedure – see more info on this on www.e-k-f.dk and you have to be aware that these types of accommodation will be **without furniture and lamps etc.**
